INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is The Dasset Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a Voluntary Controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of The Dasset Church of England Primary School".
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - 4 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 1 ex officio (foundation)
 - Up to 4 co-opted governors
5. The total number of governors is therefore a maximum of 14.
6. The term of office of all categories of governor is up to four years.
7. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Coventry Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with Parochial Church Council (PCC) of Avon Dasset and Fenny Compton-The Church of St Peter & St Clare.
8.
 - (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The incumbent of the Parish
 - (b) The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.

9. The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon are entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
10. Statement of Religious Ethos: The Dasset Primary School is a Church of England school which clearly states its expectation 'To celebrate our Christian distinctiveness' within its published school aims.
11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 29th August 2014.
12. This instrument was made by order of Warwickshire County Council on 1st June 2014.
13. A copy of the instrument will be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher, if not a governor), the trustees of the foundation of the school and the Diocesan Director of Education for the Coventry Diocesan Board of Education.
