Welcome back

We are very happy to be back at school. The children have settled well this week and we look forward to welcoming reception children next week.

We had 2 training days earlier this week. Staff have completed training on safeguarding, allergies and anaphylaxis and have been learning more about how to use concrete resources in maths lessons. Our updated policies for safeguarding, allergies and code of conduct will be available to parents on our website shortly.

Teachers will be uploading their key information regarding the curriculum as soon as they can. We are experiencing some delays with the website and parent communications ie Seesaw. Please be assured we are working on these and the issues will be ironed out as soon as possible. Uniform— The children have been very well presented this week. Thank you. On PE days please make sure that children wear plain black joggers with white t-shirt and black hoodie or school jumper. Trainers are fine for PE. No branded logos please. We only asked for one item of uniform with school logo which is our sweatshirt or cardigan. Time Keeping. Please be aware that lessons start at 8.45am therefore children should be in school by then. Doors will open at 8.40am. Classroom doors will be closed from 8.50am and after that children will have to come in via the front door so that they can be registered.

Fiddle tools. Please do not send any toys/fiddle toys into school unless the teacher requests them for learning. We cannot be held accountable for any toys that go missing or get damaged during the day. If you feel that your child needs a fiddle tool please speak to your child's class teacher who will source one for them.

Snacks. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 do not need to bring in a snack as they have a piece of fruit or vegetable provided. Key stage 2—may bring in fruit, plain biscuits, dried fruit, vegetables, cheese dippers. Snacks not allowed are crisps, chocolate, fizzy drinks. Inappropriate snacks will be taken off children and will be returned at the end of the day or returned to their lunch box if it was taken from there. We are quite relaxed where lunchboxes are concerned and allow most foods. We are a nut free school so please ensure that none are brought into school this includes Nutella (other chocolate spreads are available). **We do have children in school with allergies.**
