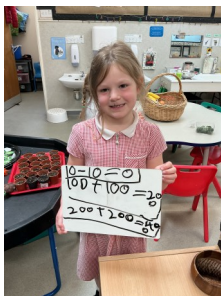
This Week:- Leaves have been awarded to the following children. The certificates will be given out in Celebration Assembly on Monday morning. Well done all of you.

Reception— The week has flown by and it been lovely to see how kind and caring the children have been as Toby has joined the Dasset family. It was great to see all the children's artwork displayed in the hall as part of our Arts Week display. They were very proud of their masks and butterflies. They worked hard using lots of different skills to make the display. In phonics we have been practising using our skills to write about the best part of our body as we start our Jigsaw topic 'Changing Me' where we looked at different parts of the body and what they are used for. In maths the children been consolidating understanding of numbers in ten by playing a take away game with cubes and a 10s frame. We have started our topic "The Big Wide World" looking at the different habitats around the world using Hannah Tolson's book Our World. In RE we started our new Understanding Christianity theme "Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians?" by listening to the story of Genesis from our Class Bible. In PE the children have been working on special awareness through individual and team games such as tag. This week the children have had different teachers as I have been on training and all of them have commented on how well behaved our class is. Well done Hedgehog class – you are amazing!



Year 1/2— It has been wonderful to welcome back a refreshed Squirrels class after the half term! In English we have enjoyed comparing the traditional story Goldilocks and the Three Bears with our new class focus book; Goldilocks and just one bear! In Maths we have been busy learning about time, starting off with sequencing events in time order, knowing the days of the week and months of the year and looking at simple units of time such as seconds, minutes and hours! In Science we have been finishing off our unit on Plant Parts and have been writing what we have learnt as part of Plant investigation by writing up our conclusions. In DT we have been adding the finishing touches to our Carnival Cars, the classroom has been full of feathers and glitter! We loved presenting all of our wonderful artwork that we produced as part of Art Week in the school gallery, we hope you were able to see it!



Year 3/4 – English this week has seen us begin to learn about the true story of Zeraffa the Giraffe - a gift in 1829 from the Pasha of Egypt to the King of France, and whose journey through France delighted all onlookers... In maths we have been applying our newfound decimal notation knowledge to money, estimations, calculations and conversions thereon. Our history work has moved from ancient Mesopotamia to ancient Egypt, considering some of their defining features and inventions. In PSHE we commenced our new unit on Changing Me, looking at how babies (for mammals) are born; whilst in RE we moved to conclude our unit on the practise of various faith groups (this week looking at Islam and Hinduism). PE saw us commence cricket lessons whilst indoor PE began an ancient Egyptian inspired unit on gymnastics. Friday afternoon saw us start our preparations for next week's class assembly with an initial assignment of parts, stage blocking and music rehearsal. French, computing and whole class reading have also taken place.



Year 5/6 - A very busy week in year 5/6 getting some excellent pieces of writing completed. We worked on a short film called 'Oktapodi' all about octopuses. We wrote a newspaper report for this. We also wrote to Miss Corry trying to persuade her to either not ban football or that she should! In maths we had a look at coordinates and concentrated on the first quadrant. We've also done several Mastering Number sessions and focused on understanding the x9 times tables. Year 5 had a great enrichment activity on Tuesday afternoon from the Smallpeice Trust. We took part in the Road to RIAT - Meet the STEM Superstars virtual session. This followed from the glider day we did earlier in the year. We listened to some different people who worked in STEM, specifically working with aeroplanes, and what their careers involved. In DT we learnt about the Make Do and Mend campaign in the Second World War. This will lead to a sewing project in a few weeks. And in French we learnt how to say where we'd like to see different animals.



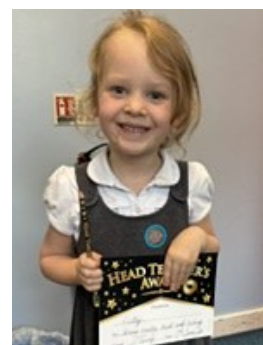
Staffing for 2025-2026
